# WHY YOU SHOULD CHOOSE CAMPUS HOUSING

- For the past three years, residents living in our thematic communities maintained higher cumulative GPAs than those living in our nonthematic housing.
- Last year, students living in thematic communities had higher cumulative GPAs than the average of the entire UNLV undergraduate population.
- Residents living in thematic communities reported a higher level of overall satisfaction with their on-campus living experience.
